

Please take your time to read through our terms and conditions carefully, as it sets out the basis of the relationship between Go As You Please Woodland Funerals Ltd ("the Company") and you as a customer ("you").

Rights of Burial

The Company owns the land at Seven Penny Meadow. Purchase of a burial plot entitles you to exclusive use of that plot for burial for ninety-nine years. You will not acquire any legal or beneficial interest in the land, except for the Right to Burial, which is applicable regardless of site ownership.

Plot locations are assigned by the Company at the time of need unless otherwise agreed in advance.

Natural wicker coffins are supplied as standard, however requests for coffins of other materials will be considered as long as they are made from natural or untreated biodegradable materials e.g. cardboard, wood.

Bodies must not be embalmed prior to burial.

Burials will only take place upon supply of the necessary documentation from the Registrar/Coroner.

The Company will carry out the preparation of the grave and any associated work. Your friends/family may assist with this by prior arrangement; however, no liability will be accepted by the Company for any accidents or injuries that occur during this process.

Exhumation will only be carried out upon supply of an approved licence from the Ministry of Justice. It will be carried out using a third-party specialist contractor and there is a minimum charge of £10,000 for this.

Memorials

Grave marker plaques are permitted at the discretion of the Company. Only plaques supplied by the Company are permitted and a cost will be incurred for this service. Plaques must be constructed of natural materials (wood, natural stone), must not exceed 9 inches by 9 inches, must be laid flush to the ground and must include the plot reference when relevant. One plaque is allowed per person (deceased). Multiple names can go on one plaque. The Company reserve the right to remove (without notice) plaques not conforming to these requirements. It is compulsory to purchase a plaque for an ashes burial.

Planting of trees is permitted at the discretion of the Company. A cost will be incurred for this service and the Company must be informed prior to burial if this service is desired as it may dictate plot location. Type and location of trees must be sympathetic to a sustainable and natural environment. One tree is allowed per plot. The Company reserve the right to remove (without notice) trees planted without their prior approval.

Planting of approved bulbs and native wildflowers on your plot is permitted. Approved bulbs include daffodil, tulip, crocus, bluebell, snowdrop, fritillary, wild garlic, and wood anemone. Planting elsewhere on site may be considered at the discretion of the Company. The Company reserve the right to remove (without notice) any planting performed without their prior approval.

Floral displays and ornaments are permitted at the time of burial. These will be removed and disposed of after a period of 14 days unless the family of the deceased wishes to remove them prior to this. After this period they are not allowed.

Real cut flowers are permitted at all other times; however plastic wrapping must be removed. Dead flowers will be removed and disposed of.

Benches supplied by the Company only are permitted. The Company reserve the right to remove (without notice) any other benches placed at Seven Penny Meadow.

Historical benches are permitted to remain until such time they become dilapidated or unsafe, at which point they will be removed and are not permitted to be replaced.

Bench brass memorial plaques are available for purchase from the Company which will go on dedicated shared benches. These are brass plaques sized 6 inches x 3 inches. Only plaques supplied by the Company are permitted. The Company reserve the right to remove (without notice) any other plaques placed on the benches.

All other forms of grave decoration and memorial are NOT permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, unapproved headstones, unapproved plants, memorial benches, ornaments, pots, vases, glass, structures, objects or articles. The Company reserve the right to remove these (without notice).

Visiting Seven Penny Meadow

Visitors are welcome at any time and are expected to be respectful to the deceased already present, as well as the natural environment of Seven Penny Meadow.

Please ensure that you take any litter home with you, close gates, use pedestrian entrances and pathways etc.

Well behaved dogs on a lead are welcome, but please clean up after them.

Vehicle access is limited to the car parking area only.
